Christian Mentors is designed for children ages 6-18, and offers access to sources of positive guidance, direction, support, and motivation for youth in alternative care homes, single and dual parent families, and families that have been affected by divorce. As part of our mentoring program, we offer seminars and family retreats with dedicated guest speakers, in hopes of strengthening the family unit by providing practical tools and guidance to equip parents for parenting, and teach adolescents how to become responsible, productive adults.

Mentoring Matters

Try this exercise...Think back to when you were a child. Who were the adults in your life you respected most? Though you weren't very close, they knew your name. You looked up to them and admired them. Now imagine, one of these adults comes to you and says...

"I think you are an outstanding individual. I've been praying about it and whatever you become, I want to see you win spiritually and vocationally for the rest of your life. I want to help you in any way I can. Whenever we meet I will ask you two questions: What are your priorities, and how can I help?"

A Success Story

Consider Mark...just one of the many success stories of Christian Mentors. Mark was a youth involved with Christian Mentors. Mark's grades were Cs and Ds before being matched with Steve, his mentor. Mark had no desire to finish high school. Today Mark is an honor role student and is pursuing a career as a helicopter pilot.

Why Mentor?

Some statistics to support mentoring...

- 64% students developed more **positive attitudes toward school**
- 58% achieved **higher grades**
- 60% **improved relationships with adults** and 56% **improved relationships with peers**
- 55% were better able to **express feelings**
- 64% developed **higher self-confidence**
- 62% were more likely to **trust their teachers**

There are many children who feel disconnected because of the circumstances in which they live, especially ones from single-parent families. These children need to be reconnected. Having a mentor who cares about them and someone they feel comfortable talking to helps motivate children to succeed.
