Mental Health Services



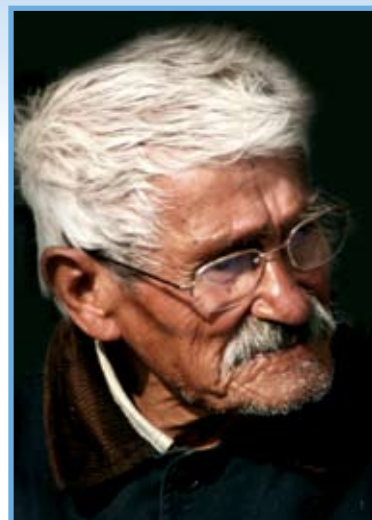
We provide growth, development, recovery and hope to thousands of people each year. In perhaps the most difficult of circumstances or in the midst of an individual's darkest hour, these services

Daybreak Adult Day Services

Our Services provide a warm, nurturing and safe environment for frail and elderly loved ones suffering from Alzheimer's, dementia or other physical limitations. This program provides day care and respite for

families caring for their loved ones in their home. In addition, this service offers the added support that caregivers need in order to maintain their own physical and mental health.

Mission Villas Senior Housing

Mission Villas Senior Housing located in the community of Rubidoux, provides quality low income housing and serves as an affordable alternative to seniors in need. Today the beautiful 54 unit complex is a safe, secure, comfortable home to its senior residents. This project was a labor of love, commitment and perseverance which continues to grow.

Senior Nutrition Services



We provide nutritious meals to seniors throughout Riverside and San Bernardino

Counties serving 3,500 seniors a day. Our program assists seniors and their loved ones in helping to maintain their independence. The Senior Nutrition Program provides two separate services; the Congregate or "Group Meals" served at our Community Centers, and the Home Delivered Meals known as the "More Than A Meal" program.

The Group Meals provide:

- Warm, delicious and nutritionally balanced meals to seniors in a group setting.
- Seniors are able to socialize with others and experience nutritional training seminars which assist them with eating a more balanced and healthy diet.

The *More Than a Meal* program provides:

- Healthy meals feeding seniors, body, heart and soul.
- It also allows seniors the chance to remain living at home independently for as long as possible, while being assured that they receive at least one nutritious meal each day.
- The additional benefit comes from the social contact they have with the driver's who deliver their meals. It may be the only interaction they have in a given day and combats the terrible isolation that many home bound seniors might experience.
